Types of Retail	Full vaccination date
Essential Retail (e.g., supermarkets, markets, petrol station, pet store)	Vaccination not required
General Retail (e.g., retail clothing stores, auction houses)	24 November**
Restricted Retail (e.g., hairdressing, beauty, tattoo and piercing)	23 October, or 29 October in regional Victoria

^{*} Employers must sight and record worker's vaccination information (including information regarding a medical exemption from vaccination), and businesses must check the vaccination or exempt status of a customer who attends their premises.

Documents that can be provided to check vaccination status or exempt status are:

- COVID-19 digital certificate using the Service Victoria app
- COVID-19 digital certificate in a smart phone wallet
- printed copy of COVID-19 digital certificate or immunisation history statement
- Australian Immunisation Register certificate
- a <u>valid medical exemption</u> from vaccination
- as of 6pm on Friday 12 November 2021, the excepted person will need to provide an immunisation history statement obtained from the "Australian Immunisation Register" as proof of their exempt status - this can be obtained through a medical practitioner.

The quickest and easiest way for businesses to check vaccination status is via the **Service Victoria app** when customers check-in using the Victorian Government QR code.
